2. Letter of Interest (max. 1 page)

Personal statement, describing why you are interested in participating in the IPHS program including your future scientific career goals

3. Curriculum Vitae

- Personal data
- Individual achievements (e.g. scholarships, prizes, publications)

4. Secondary School Certificate

5. University Degree Certificates and Academic Record

- Proof of initial enrolment ('Ersteinschreibung') for Bachelor and Master studies (e.g. proof of matriculation from first semester, 'Studienverlaufsbescheinigung', etc.)
- Bachelor's degree certificate
- Master's degree/diploma certificate, academic record, abstract of master's/diploma thesis (1 2 pages)
- copy of master's/diploma thesis (as extra PDF)

6. **Doctoral Project Proposal**

- Focused thesis proposal in the field of Health Sciences including: subject and summary of the project (max. 3 pages, in English)
 - short introduction to the state of the field (background),
 - specific aim(s) of the project,
 - working hypothesis/scientific question,
 - description of the experimental strategy/methods,
 - working and time schedule (e.g. as Gantt chart),
 - alternative plans for unforeseen obstacles (optional),
 - integration of the planned project into the surrounding of the Clinic/Institute.
 - literature and list of abbreviations (as Appendix, can be placed on page 4).
