CECAD is the unifying driving force bringing together researchers and clinicians of the University, University Hospital and MPIs for Biology of Ageing and Metabolism Research in Cologne. Funding: 861 €/month

on a full-time basis**

We encourage highly motivated students to apply by April 1, 2021 at the latest.

The application should include:

- a CV
- a letter of motivation (max. 1 page)
- a brief description of the research project (incl. project title and name of supervisor): 3/4 - 1 page
- supporting letter by the hosting CECAD group leader (prerequisite for funding!)
- approximate starting date
